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Conte[n]t presented before William Chapoyne & John Sturges

Squire w^t in the parishes of Otteley lethely Mkeley lighley & Malhoum in
the west Rythyng of the Countye of yorke by virtue of the Kinge in writ^{ty} in
comission to theyn & othe[r] dyrected to t^{he} of theyn &c

The churchwarden of the parish of Otteley seith upon the
other that they is a chapell in ffewely moth togyd with lede wherof pte
is spoiled & yeu in the sundred stalles & glasse stalled away bot by

The whiche they knowe not. they sey the spoile was made in the defaute of
the parish of
Otteley
On Cristes daye p^rst that longe wylle they & had the lede in keping &
suffred the doore to stonde opyn & a shepetote to be made therof

The said Comissioner seith that the lede on the said chapell
melted into xxij gyle peser ozel & aboue xxij webber pte not melted &
xxxj littill peser of the asshe whith xxij peser was deliuid by the
comissioner to oon John hedson withtunt of yorke don in lade to the said

John standt & touzred to yorke & weid thei at the kunge in beue by willm
Eulwyn weynatst thei at apperth by a bill of the same willm hereunto
tuneced by hym assigned & weith 2 fother 2 ^l & 11 1/2

Item payed by Rithard leucatt & George Dyo smyth to the
Comffion of all the wode within the chapell at forwed of baggage left
undiqued at melting of the lede wode by theym to staze the thynge of
the same besyned witht amountith to 22 ^l 12 ^d

ozd & adoue 21 ^l 21 ^d payed for the same wode at apperth by a bill

kunge is inuestye & hath lettyn the same to William siglesworth for xx^d
by yere

Item the thynghsayden seith y^t the said an Cristofer wade p^rst hath in
his hande xx^{li} in money gevyu by oon p^rizall wade wherewith to by londe

of xx^d by yere & they wth to kepe an obite & dele money for the same
priuatly for ead

Itm they saw in Dunelm thapell gathen by the tyeed & my littill tyeed
solde to Crist amaste Gent for xij^s my^d forsomoth at ou Dunelm
thaned the same tyeed by tofot of the Snyper against the kunge
saying they were not the kunge & the wth money penytyeth in the
handes of John Landt Comission

Itm they saw a littill thapell at Otteley brydge ende spoiled of white
stone & the walled the Comission sold to Thoma Higley Squire

Item ---illegible--- Eghley & the wife of Geoffrey Shaliden of the same
unlawfully tuncleth from the king & with a piece of wood called the
stump stande nigh Goddyside ende in Eghley the rent & charge was con-
ceded to the funding of a stump light in Eghley church & now unlawfully
tuncled by the said tenant & is worth by year 2^d
