

# Bill of Henry Ambler v Robert, William and John Halle 1552/3

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To the Right Wylfulfull þ (Richard Sackvyle Knight Chanceller  
of the Exchequer Comptroller of Augmentacions of the revenues of his M<sup>tes</sup>tie

In moste humble wise sheweth unto yo<sup>r</sup> wysshipp yo<sup>r</sup> Davyde Wats<sup>r</sup> Henry Ambler of Byghley  
yn the Countie of York husbandman that shoo is Walter Passer of Kildesden yn the  
Countie of Northfolke Esquire and other who reside yn thon domes as of ffoe of and yn a  
copynd tenementt with thapptou<sup>nc</sup>e sett lying & boving yn Byghley Northfolke to thoutent that  
ho the said Walter and his said heffer shoulde take thissuoz & revenues thereof and the

ffittte thowk among shuldo bestowde & distyrbte yowly to the fynyng of a Fyfte to dyng masse  
yn the church of Byghloy shyrosorde before the image of s<sup>r</sup> Marye thow and alle of and yn one  
porce of grounde contaynyng by estymacion tenn acres with thapptownc yn Byghloy shyrosorde to  
thuse & yntoutt that the sode Walter and his sode trofessor shuldo with the yowly persons  
thowk fynde a lyght of Fycho hymnyng continually before the image of s<sup>r</sup> Marye shyrosorde during  
the tyme of the messe yn the same church to be celebrato and as sode sode sode  
granted & lorde the same to ys<sup>r</sup> sode Fycho To have to have for the tyme of certayne  
yowly witt yott espynde yowlyng to the sode Walter and his sode trofessor xxij<sup>s</sup> and of youtt  
payable att the feste of whitsontide and sode martyno yn wynton by oren persons by force  
thowk ys<sup>r</sup> sode wate<sup>r</sup> outyde yn to the pnyssor and the ffittte thowk hath pordordly hadde

procure & take up by the space of thise xx<sup>i</sup> yeres or more wth only shewe that of the  
Dissolucion of thantonyr made the first yere of the reign of o<sup>r</sup> Soverign kyng the kyng thatt  
was is by whiche acte all the pynsses were restid in the kyngs maiestie and ys<sup>r</sup> shewe  
thatt became the kyngs Count butt also on<sup>e</sup> o<sup>r</sup> o<sup>r</sup>ther untill was of late certeyn yett<sup>r</sup> and

dosist from the possession & occupacon of the pynssoz and no moze to outpymodde yn the same  
untill the kyng title be fully hord & detourmynd and ys<sup>a</sup> owde vnto<sup>a</sup> shall dayly paye to godd for  
the pspens contynuaunce of ys<sup>a</sup> godd aysshipp yn mocho wyshipp tounqoraco
